THE ACADEMY

The Science Museum Group is the market leader for STEM engagement in the UK in the museum sector. Our Science Museum site in London is the most visited museum for educational visits in the country, with our interactive galleries and exciting exhibitions continuously sparking wonder and curiosity.

In 2018 we launched the Science Museum Group Academy, a dedicated centre of excellence to provide science engagement training for educators, employees of cultural organisations, and professionals working in science, technology, engineering and maths (STEM).

Grounded in more than 25 years of research and over 90 years of engaging audiences within our five museums, the Academy training courses play an essential role in helping to address the challenges of low science engagement among adults and young people. Since its launch, thousands of teachers, museum educators, scientists and industry professionals have benefited from science engagement training.

Every training session is underpinned by academic and science education research, including the concept of 'science capital', which the Science Museum Group developed with King's College London and University College London to help transform the way professionals communicate with their audiences.

WHAT IS SCIENCE CAPITAL?

Science capital is a measure of your engagement or relationship with science, how much you value it and whether you feel it is 'for you'.

It highlights the significance of external influences in shaping attitudes towards STEM – for example what you know about science, how you think about it, what science-related activities you do, and the people you know who use and talk about science.

The Science Museum Group Academy gives us a unique opportunity to roll out at scale impactful engagement techniques underpinned by this research.



INTERNATIONAL REACH

By making our training available globally, we are developing partnerships to help inspire teachers, educators and STEM professionals, who in turn will give young people from the widest range of backgrounds the skills, confidence and inspiration to make a difference in tomorrow's world. These partnerships aid in making science truly open for all and in engaging new audiences across diverse regions.

In addition, our continued professional development (CPD) training ensures that we share our expertise with museums, cultural institutions and other organisations to help them progress and succeed in today's world.

BRONZE LEVEL

Our Bronze package consists of an introduction to science capital and an overview of best practice in engaging all audiences with science. Further courses from our standard CPD offer can be added to give a well-rounded introduction to museum practice.

It is also suitable for commercial organisations keen to learn how best to engage with their audiences, either generally or in ways related to specific products.

Training will be based on our already developed suite of CPD or science engagement courses, but with the courses fully tailored to suit you.

This package is best suited for institutions that already practise science engagement and are looking to embed further insights from science capital research into their daily practice, or those keen to develop in much greater detail particular areas of staff CPD.

We will work with your local team to give them the tools and skills to provide their own world-class training to local teachers and/or STEM professionals, to aid science communication and raise science engagement, leading to wider community engagement with science and promotion of crucial STEM jobs locally. We provide continued support and frequent touch points throughout the programme.

On successful completion of the training, your institution will become a Science Museum Group Academy Hub. Over time this will provide access to a network of other Hubs worldwide, continued exchange of knowledge and learning, and leverage to local government for key initiatives. Refresher training is also given after the Hub has been created, to ensure that learning is kept up to date and relevant.

This package is best suited for museums with experience in science engagement that want to become a dedicated centre of excellence, or for organisations looking to enable a local institution to become a sponsored Hub facility.
